Executive Summary

The Data Management Plan aims to provide an overview of the data used and generated over the course of this project, and how it will be handled not only during the project, but also after its lifetime, whilst adhering to the FAIR principles (Findable, Accessible, Interoperable and Reusable data) and by adhering special attention to data security and improving access to research data. This will be done by specifying what type of data will become open access, how they will be shared and through which repository.

This data management plan will provide an overview of the information, reports and datasets (re)used and generated during the course of the project. The use of input data will be set forth, and the DMP will clarify how that input data will be used, including its provenance and main characteristics. More importantly, the focus will be put on the research data that was generated during the project and can be considered a fruitful result of TRACY. A description will be given of how the input data was used to develop the cleaned, enriched and transformed synthetic dataset as output.

It will be clarified how TRACY ensures the Findability, Accessibility, Interoperability and Reusability of the project's output data, in order to share its positive and useful results which can have clear impact outside of this project. This DMP will also provide insight into how the data was stored securely throughout the project, and what measures have been taken to ensure the data's long-term preservation after the project.

Not only the FAIR principles and data security, but also ethical and legal considerations – especially in light of dissemination of the output – have been appropriately implemented within TRACY, whilst proportionally allocating the necessary resources within the project's budget.
